

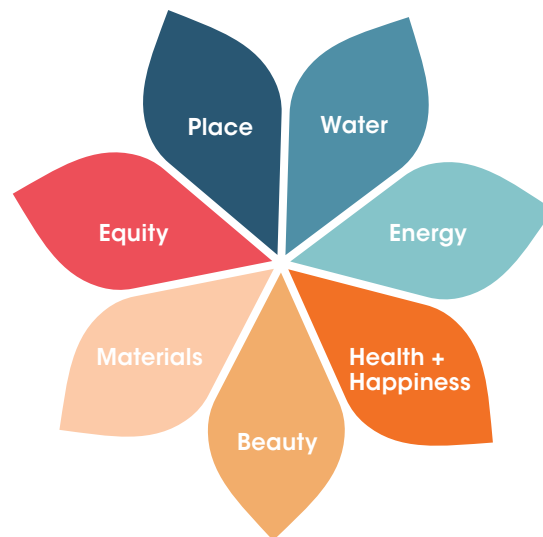


What is the Living Building Challenge (LBC)?


The Living Building Challenge, created and operated by the International Living Future Institute (ILFI), identifies itself as the world’s most ambitious, advanced, and holistic performance standard for green, resilient, and healthy buildings. The intent is to drive design and creation of buildings that do more good than harm, creating a positive impact on humans and natural systems.

How is the LBC organized?

LBC imagines a building that is as efficient as a flower; a simple symbol for the ideal built environment. The Living Building Challenge is organized into 7 performance categories called Petals: Place, Water, Energy, Health + Happiness, Materials, Equity, and Beauty.
